At the Executive Management Committee meeting of February 2, 2012, the Members of the California Transmission Planning Group ("CTPG") decided to suspend the development of a 2012 Statewide Transmission Plan until further notice. This action was taken in order to provide the Members time during which their participation in the CPTG, and the mission of the CTPG itself, could be reevaluated in light of the issuance of Order 1000 by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission. The Members agreed to address the implications of Order 1000 and the future of the CTPG's activities at the meeting of the Executive Management Committee to be held on April 5, 2012, in Sacramento, California. The meeting will be open to the public and your comments, as always, are welcome.
